4. Involvement in school and community activities
5. Financial need
6. Other (e.g., work experience)

In order to qualify, candidates must be **current** members of District Two - Sons of Norway or children or grandchildren of **current** members of District Two - Sons of Norway. The applicant must have met the entrance requirements (e.g., completion of at least one year of studies at the university level) and been accepted to attend the International Summer School at the University of Oslo. You can apply for the school online starting December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016. This scholarship will provide the winner with tuition, room, and board.
